01 General Information

The MingClassics Violin Competition is part of the MingClassics Academy & Festival Switzerland 2026, held in Andermatt, Switzerland. The competition provides outstanding young violinists with an international platform for artistic development, performance, and professional exposure.

02 Competition Structure

2.1 Preliminary Round

Live performance is required

Piano accompaniment will be provided

The jury will award the following prizes:

First Prize (Outstanding), First Prize, Second Prize, Third Prize, Merit Award

Candidates awarded First Prize (Outstanding) selected for the Final Round.

2.2 Final Round

Selected candidates will perform with orchestra at the Andermatt Concert Hall.

Candidates perform one movement of a concerto or a work designated by the organizer.

2.3 Winners' Concert

Prize winners (excluding finalists) will perform in a public Winners' Concert with piano accompaniment.

03 Repertoire Requirements

First Round

Candidates must choose one of the following works.

Piano accompaniment is required.

- Johann Sebastian Bach – Sonata in G minor, BWV 1020
- Antonio Vivaldi – Concerto in A minor, RV 461
- Alessandro Marcello – Concerto in D minor

Final Round

- Domenico Cimarosa – Concerto for Oboe and String Orchestra

Finalists will perform with the MingClassics Chamber Orchestra at the Andermatt Concert Hall.

04 Prizes & Opportunities

Third Prize and Merit Awards

Final Round: Grand Prize

All prize winners will receive official certificates issued by the organizer.
